NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT ORDINANCE BY THE BOROUGH OF SAEGERTOWN

Notice is hereby given that the Borough Council of the Borough of Saegertown, Crawford County, Pennsylvania, intends to consider and ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Amending the Code of the Borough of Saegertown to Incorporate Licensing Fees, Taxes, and Regulations for Mechanical Amusement Devices and Gaming Establishments" at its regular meeting on September 8, 2025 at 6 p.m. The purpose of the ordinance is to regulate and tax mechanical amusement devices, gaming establishments, pool halls, and locations with legal gaming machines to ensure public safety, compliance, and proper oversight. Key provisions include: Definitions of amusement devices, gambling devices, jukeboxes, pool tables, and related terms; Licensing requirements for amusement devices, including application procedures, fees, and eligibility criteria; Conditions for issuance of licenses, inspection rights, and penalties for violations; Prohibition of illegal gambling devices and declaration of contraband for violations.
