NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT ORDINANCE BY THE BOROUGH OF SAEGERTOWN

NOTICE is given that the Borough of Saegertown Council intends to consider the passing of an Ordinance to be known as **AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE PROTECTION OF PERSONS AND PROPERTY FROM UNLAWFUL TRESPASS OR SQUATTING AND PROVIDING RIGHTS, REMEDIES AND PENALTIES THEREFORE.**

This Ordinance establishes rights for the protection of persons and property within the borough from trespassers, squatters and phroggers. This ordinance acknowledges the rights of property owners to be free from such persons and provides for remedies and penalties to eliminate such unlawful activities. Saegertown Borough Council shall consider the passing of this ordinance at it April 8, 2024, meeting at 6:00 p.m. at the Saegertown Borough Building located at 603 Erie Street, Saegertown, Pennsylvania.
