## Recycling Electronics for Residents and Businesses: Limit 2 items

Each additional item will cost \$5.00 each. The following can be dropped off: TV’s – Computers – VCR’s – Radios – Copiers - Laptops – Cell phones.

**NO items from out of town.** All items to be recycled must be from a Borough Business or Residence.

## Colored Flags in Your Yard:

Small colored flags in your yard are to mark underground utilities.

- White: marks where someone is going to dig.
- Blue: water lines
- Yellow: natural gas lines
- Pink: survey marks
- Red: underground electric lines
- Green: sewer and drain lines

Do NOT move them until the excavation is complete.

**9-1-1 back-up number:**

Recently the state 9-1-1 system has experienced some problems. There is a back-up number you can use. Store it on your cell phone just in case: **814-724-2548** for emergencies only, if 9-1-1 does not work.

**Safety Tip: Flash Floods**

The recent flash floods in Texas, and the flooding in North Carolina from the hurricanes, are a reminder to pay attention to weather alerts, watches, and warnings.

- Weather Alert: notifies of possible conditions that may affect safety.
- Weather Watch: conditions are favorable for severe weather.
- Weather Warning: a condition is occurring or is imminent.

Remember: we live in an area that is susceptible to flash floods and flooding!

**Pay attention to Weather Updates!!!**

**NOAA Weather Radio:**

An inexpensive weather alert radio can be purchased for about \$32. Models can be charged by electricity, battery, solar and or a hand crank. These radios alert you to any severe weather in your local area.
