Snow Parking – Starts November 1st:

Be prepared for winter. Review of the streets affected, and the days and times. (Nov. 1 to April 1)

- No Parking Any Time: All the streets on Saeger-Heights.
- No Parking midnight to 7:00 am: Main Street and Erie Street.
- No Parking Odd-Even days: (9 am to 4 pm)
 - no parking on Odd days (1-3-5- etc.) on the South and East sides of all other streets.
 - no parking on Even days (2-4-6 etc.) on the North and West sides of all other streets.

Dog Poop: Respect our Workers...

Make sure raked leaves and bagged leaves do not have dog poop in them.

- We will not pick up leaves with poop in them.
- We will charge for meter reading if we have to walk through poop to read it!

Private snow plowing

Do not plow snow on someone else's property without permission.

Do not plow snow onto or across Streets or roads. Both are finable offenses.

Snow on Main St. Sidewalks

The Borough will blow snow from all the Main Street sidewalks again this year. However, it may not be done until later in the morning. Property owners are responsible for cleaning off snow and ice in the meantime.

Safety Tip: Christmas Safety

- Keep potentially poisonous plants like mistletoe or holly away from children.
- If you use an artificial tree, make sure it is "fire resistant".
- If you use a live tree, keep it watered (cut about 2 inches off the bottom when you put it up)
- Keep trees at least 3 feet from heat sources.
- Use indoor lights indoors, and outside light outdoors. Do not mix them up.
- Replace lights with frayed cords, and do not use extension cords.
- Use artificial candles...not real ones...they are a main cause of Christmas fires.
- Turn off all lights and candles when you leave or go to bed.
