## **Garbage Collection...Follow the Rules**

- Frequently, garbage cans are spread all over the streets after pick-up.
- We have addressed the issue with the refuse contractor. Residents also need to follow the rules and remove cans from streets and berms after pickup.
- All garbage must be placed at the curb by 8:00 am Monday morning.
- Garbage cannot be placed at the curb prior to 24 hours before pick-up. (8:00 am Sunday)
- All garbage cans must be removed from the street by 8:00 am Tuesday morning (day after pick-up).**
- No garbage may be brought in from out of town. (If you see this happening, please call the Borough office)
- If garbage is spilled or animals scatter it, it is your job to pick it up!



## **Snow and garbage...**

- When you know snow is coming, and the Boro will have to plow, watch where you place your garbage.
- If the Boro hits your garbage with a snowplow, it is your responsibility to clean it up!
- When there is snow, please use colored garbage bags so the refuse collectors can see it.

## **Water Bills can be e-mailed to you:**

The Borough is offering to e-mail water bills to customers this year.

E-mail the Borough and state you want your water/refuse bills e-mailed to you.

NOTE: We cannot automatically deduct from your bank account. You can pay with your online banking, as before, but you must include your Borough account number.

Customers that wish to continue to have their bills mailed to them will receive a \$1 monthly charge per unit.

## Snow Parking – November 1<sup>st</sup> to April 1<sup>st</sup>.

Be prepared for winter. Review of the streets affected, and the days and times. (Nov. 1 to April 1)

-No Parking Any Time: All the streets on Saeger-Heights.

-No Parking midnight to 7:00 am: Main Street and Erie Street.

-No Parking Odd-Even days: (9 am to 4 pm)

-no parking on Odd days (1-3-5- etc.) on the South and East sides of all other streets.

-no parking on Even days (2-4-6 etc.) on the North and West sides of all other streets.

The Borough will blow snow from all the Main Street sidewalks again this year. However, it may not be done until later in the morning. Property owners are responsible for cleaning off snow and ice in the meantime.
