Garbage Contract: Good News

The Borough’s current Refuse Contract ends Dec. 31, 2025. The contractor and the Borough have agreed to a 2-year extension of the present contract. Prices will remain the same until Dec. 31, 2027. No other changes.

Water Consumer Confidence Report (CCR):

The annual water quality report is now available for review. It is on our website: saegertownpa.com. There is a direct link from the home page Titled: Annual CCR.

Or you can Go to: Services, then Water Department, then “Consumer Confidence Report”. This is an annual report required by Pa DEP and lists all the compounds tested for in our water, and any contaminants detected.



Water Project Update:

The new water treatment plant is under construction behind the Borough Building and new water line construction along Erie St. will start in the near future.

Rt. 19 Bridge Project:

Things are progressing with the bridge replacement as planned. A fall opening is still projected.

Recycling Electronics for Residents and Businesses: Limit 2 items

Once again, the **Jordan Family Foundation** will be sponsoring electronics recycling during the month of **August**. Two items can be dropped off at the Borough Building for free. Each additional item will cost \$5.00 each.

The following can be dropped off: TV’s – Computers – VCR’s – Radios – Copiers - Laptops – Cell phones.

NO items from out of town. All items to be recycled must be from a Borough Business or Residence.

Annual Yard Sales Day – July 19th – No Permit is needed.

Set-up on Friday and tear down by Monday. No commercial sales at private residences.



Paint and Hazardous Materials:

- Paint:** if you let paint completely dry you can place it out with your garbage without the lid on. Floor dry, kitty litter or commercial products expedite the paint drying.
- Hazardous Materials:** watch the Crawford County website (solid waste) for disposal information.

Trees:

- If you plan to have a tree removed: make sure it is not a borough tree by calling the Borough Office.
- Also, plan to have the wood and brush removed, the Borough will not take wood or brush from trees that have been removed. -New tree planting should be from the approved tree list, which is posted on our website.

E-mail notification & Website:

Residents and water customers should register for our e-mail notification list.

And check out our website (saegertownpa.com) for updates such as water leaks or disasters.

The Boro provided e-mails and several updates during the recent major fire, and broken water lines this spring.

Signs: What are the Regulations for Temporary Signs? – with No permit needed.

- All Temporary sign such as "Watch for Motorcycles" are limited to 4 square ft. (generally - 1 ½ ft. by 2 ft.)
- Multiple signs cannot exceed 16 sq. ft. total on a property. (maximum 5)
- "For Sale" or "For Rent" are permitted using the 4 sq. ft. restriction
- Signs for contractors, builders, etc. are permitted while the work is going on (maximum 50 weeks)
- Public auctions, yard sales and garage sales signs, permitted if less than 72 hours duration but removed after the event.
- Commemoration signs (i.e. graduation) are permitted for 7 days.
- No signs on Borough owned property without permission.
- No signs on private property or the rights-of ways adjoining the property without the property owner's permission.
- No signs advertising businesses from out of the Borough.
- Signs must be maintained in good shape and placed upright.
- No signs in either roundabout or the entrances and exits to them.
- All other permanent signs or larger signs require a Borough permit.
- There are per-day fines for violations.

Safety Tip: Lawnmowing

- Do NOT wear sandals or bare feet
- Do NOT mow over gravel
- Do NOT leave the keys in a riding mower
- Caution mowing hills...go up and down...not sideways
- If you want to unclog a chute, adjust the height of blades or inspect the blades...shut the mower OFF.
- Children: Do NOT let under 12 use a push mower or under 16 use a riding mower. And Do NOT give kids rides while mowing.
- Pick up rocks sticks and other debris before starting
- Do NOT pull a mower backward – you can easily slip and fall
- Remove the spark plug when working on a lawnmower
- Wear Eye and Ear protection
