**The annual CASH BASH will be held on Saturday June 7th, 2025, at the Crawford County Fairgrounds.*

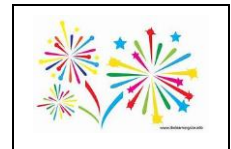
...In addition to being eligible for over 100 prizes, tickets are also good for a meal and refreshments!

Garbage Contract: Good News

The Borough's current Refuse Contract ends Dec. 31, 2025. The contractor and the Borough have agreed to a 2-year extension of the present contract. Prices will remain the same until Dec. 31, 2027. No other changes.

Water Consumer Confidence Report (CCR):

This annual water quality report is now available for review. It is on our website: saegertownpa.com. There is a direct link from the home page Titled: Annual CCR.

Or you can Go to: Services, then Water Department, then "Consumer Confidence Report". This is an annual report required by Pa DEP, and lists all the compounds tested for in our water, and any contaminants detected.

Report Violations:

We have recently had a rash of reckless driving, loud noise after 10 pm at night, and unregistered vehicles. If you observe a violation, please call PSP at 814-332-6911. Also please keep the Borough informed.

Water Project Update:

Construction has started on the water project. Expect lots of activity, and one-lane traffic along Erie St. as the project continues. A new water line will be installed the full length of Erie Street from French Creek to the reservoirs. You will also see activity along Rt. 198 near the American Legion, and behind the Borough Building.

Why all the Recent Water Leaks?

Several issues have stressed our water system this year, including weather, and a major fire. We attempt to repair every water leak as soon as possible and minimize water outages or diminished water pressure. Do not forget to check the Borough website for updates if you have water volume or pressure issues.

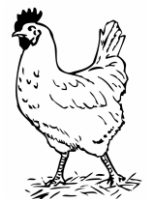
Rt. 19 Bridge Project:

Things are progressing with the bridge replacement as planned. A fall opening is still planned.

Chickens, Pigs and Ducks...Illegal!

No person, firm, partnership or corporation shall keep or maintain an apiary or any live swine or pig, live chicken, turkey, pigeon, horse, cow, goat, sheep, duck, rabbit or other domestic or wild fowl or animal within the Borough of Saegertown.

Exempted from this prohibition are those domesticated fowl or animal that can be maintained in a cage within the living confines of the owner's residence.



Annual Yard Sales Day – July 19th – No Permit is needed.

Set up Friday, tear down by Monday. No commercial sales at private residences.

Worried about Lead water lines?

How to reduce exposure to lead in drinking water:

-If water hasn't been used for several hours, run water for 15-30 seconds or until it becomes cold or reaches a steady temperature before using it for cooking or drinking. This action flushes lead-containing water from the pipes. -Use cold water for cooking or preparing baby formulas. -Do not boil water to remove lead.

Saegertown Heritage Society:

The Patrick McGill Log Cabin, located at 649 Main Street, Saegertown will be open for the first tour of the season, beginning Saturday, June 7th at 11:00 am. Owned by the Saegertown Heritage Society, this is the oldest original structure in Crawford County. Built in 1802, it is a typical cabin of the Western Pennsylvania frontier. The house was recently featured in an article "North by Northwest" in the winter issue of the **Heinz History Center** magazine. Tours of the cabin will continue through October on the first Saturday of each month, always at 11:00 am. Tours are free to the public, with parking in the rear of the building off Kern Alley. Patrick McGill along with his brother Arthur were the co-founders of our community.
