CCR...Annual Water Quality Report

This annual water quality report is now available for review. It is on our website: saegertownpa.com.

Or you can go to: Services, then Water Department, then "Consumer Confidence Report". This is an annual report required by Pa DEP and lists all the compounds tested for in our water, and any contaminants detected.

Community Yard Sales Day will be Saturday July 18th this year. No permit is needed. Set up Friday and cleaned up by Monday. All other yard sales require a free permit, and you are limited to 2 per year.

Water Project Update:

The project has been progressing and should be in service later this summer. There is still much work to be done, and lots of testing and clean-up are still needed.

Questions: on the Water Project

1. **When will it be completed?** Projected completion is early this Fall.
2. **What will it remove from the water?** PFAS – Iron - Manganese
3. **What about the calcium in the water?** That will NOT be removed.
4. **How will it affect Water Pressure?** Pressure should be more stable and not fluctuate as in the past.
5. **What about air in the lines?** Air comes from the pumping of the wells. It may or may not improve.
6. **Can I see the new treatment plant?** We plan to have an open house when the project is complete.



Garbage Pick-up:

All garbage pickup for the remainder of the year will be on Monday as scheduled until Labor Day in September.

Hantavirus...What is it?

Recently there has been a lot of media coverage on this disease that was contacted on a cruise ship.

This disease is spread by rodents such as rats & mice.

The symptoms are **Flu-like** that ends with respiratory distress.

If you have trouble breathing check with a doctor,

particularly if you were on a cruise ship or you are regularly in contact with rodents.

Precautions you can take:

1. Block any potential entrances that rodents may enter your home.
2. Use traps or rodenticide to kill and remove rodents.
3. Clean areas that have droppings with mixture of water and bleach.
4. Keep food in rodent proof containers.

Saegertown Heritage Society:

The Saegertown Heritage Society has the **McGill House** cleaned and ready for tours this season. The first guided tour will be Saturday, June 6th at 11:00 am, continuing every first Saturday through October. This structure built in 1802 is the oldest original one in Crawford County. It is outfitted as a typical Western Pennsylvania frontier cabin. The McGill House is located at 649 Main Street, with parking in the rear. A reminder: the Heritage Society's museum at the Saeger House, 375 Main Street, is open every Saturday from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm.

This year the "Changing Exhibit Room" highlights the 250th Anniversary of our country with many artifacts from 1976, including several photos of locations in town compared to how the same scene looks today.

Old Municipal Building Demolished:

The building on Broad Street that has housed the Borough Offices, the Fire Department, the Library and the Heritage Museum over the years has been demolished and will now be a parking lot.

Time Capsule Opening:
