4-Wheelers and ATV's:

PENALTY!

- *All-Terrain-Vehicles (ATVs) (including 3 and 4 wheelers and snowmobiles)
- ***Are not permitted on Borough Property or on Borough streets**, without **permission**.
- *ATV's crossing streets as prescribed by Penna. State law is permitted.
- *ATV's may only be driven on or across private property with permission of the landowner.
- *Fine: Class B: \$100 to \$1,000 per incident.



\$12,678,000 Water Project:

On March 10th the Borough awarded contracts for the new water treatment plant. Construction should start in May and will take approximately one year to complete. There will be a new water line installed on Erie St. from French Creek to the reservoirs, and a new treatment plant will be constructed behind the Borough Building. Watch future monthly newsletters for updates. Fortunately, we received a grant to cover the funding.

Rt. 19 Bridge Project:

The Rt. 19 bridge replacement project (near the fish commission access area) started in April. Rt. 19 will be closed, and I-79 will be the official detour. Jordan Drive and the South St. Bridge will be restricted to LOCAL TRAFFIC ONLY. The road was closed on April 21st. We will provide updates when they are available.

Memorial Day Garbage:

Garbage collection will be moved from Monday, May 26 to **Tuesday, May 27** due to the Memorial Day Holiday.

Lead water lines:

We completed the lead and copper survey last year as required by Pa. DEP. There has not been a timeline provided by EPA or DEP concerning the replacement of the lines. We suggest everyone waits until at least 2026 when we have more information, before you replace any lines.

Pickleball:

Borough residents can stop at the office and get the combination for the lock at the pickle ball court, this year.

New Bench at the Post Office:

The new bench at the Post Office was donated by the Women's Improvement Club. Great Project. Thanks.

Utility Solicitation: You do NOT have to show anyone copies of your bills...

The Borough has issued permits recently for individuals to solicit door-to-door selling utilities (electricity, natural gas and internet) You do NOT have to talk to any salesman, and you do NOT have to show any utility bills.





Yard Sales Permits:

Yard sales require a **FREE** permit. Only 2 sales per year are permitted. Call the office for details and a permit.

Annual Yard Sales Day – July 19th – No Permit is needed. Set up Friday, clean up by Monday.

“Celebrate Saegertown Day” – August 9th.

Spring Turkey season is the month of May. Hunting in the Borough is permitted except in Safety Zones.

Brush and Yard Waste:

The Borough started picking up brush April 1st. It must be neatly piled and no longer than 5 feet.

We will **NOT** take entire trees. Make arrangements to have brush removed when you take down a tree.

We can **NOT** pick up dirt or yard debris. Plant clippings must be in clear bags to be picked up. NO Grass Clippings.

Also, Flash Floods, Creek Flooding and Brush Fires are possible. Take weather alerts seriously!!

- **Weather Warning:** Events are imminent or are in progress. Take cover or follow instructions.
- **Weather Watch:** Conditions are right for weather events to happen. Pay attention.
- **Weather Advisory:** Conditions are occurring that are less serious, but caution should be taken.

-If Tornados or Floods are **imminent** the disaster siren will blow 3 times for one minute each.
