Yard Waste: What we will pick up...

The Borough will only pick up sticks and leaves. Leaves must be bagged in clear bags, and sticks must be in neat piles, no longer than 5 feet long. We will NOT pick up grass clippings, rocks, dirt or moss.

Garbage on Memorial Day: Change

There will be NO garbage pickup on Memorial Day, May 25th. Pickup will be on Tuesday May 26th.

Community Yard Sales:

Community Yard Sales Day will be Saturday July 18th this year. No permit is needed. Set up Friday and cleaned up by Monday. All other yard sales require a free permit, and you are limited to 2 per year.



Basketball Hoops:

Portable baseball hoops along streets must be placed off the street, and the hoop must not stick out over the edge of the street. You can be responsible for damage to garbage, delivery and fire trucks if they hit the hoop.

Spring Turkey Season:

Spring turkey season starts in early May. It is legal to hunt in the Borough provided you have permission from the landowner, and you do not shoot within 150 yards of a residence. Follow game laws and be sure of your target!

Baseball is in Season – Drive Carefully

Be extremely careful when driving in the area of Jordan Park on Erie St. Foul balls cross the street. Watch for kids!

Respect Wildlife:

Spring is when wild baby birds and animals are born. Don't pick up wild babies that you think are orphans. Chances are the mother is nearby.

Make sure garbage and pet food are secure and animals cannot get into them. Crows, raccoons, bears, dogs and cats are the main garbage spreading culprits.



Ticks...they are in the Borough.

Ticks can cause lime disease and other diseases so use caution when working outdoors. Treating clothes with Permethrin is a good deterrent. Also check dogs and cats for ticks when they return from outdoors.

Safety Tip: Grass & Brush Fires... Use Caution

Spring is the season for grass and brush fires.

Do not burn outdoors during dry or windy conditions.

Use caution when burning, even after a rain.

Wind quickly dries out the tops of dead grass that will burn easily and spread rapidly.

Remember: Outdoor burning of any kind - requires a permit.
