Grant Awarded to Saegertown for Water Treatment:

CELEBRATE!

\$12,678,000

The Borough recently received a grant for almost thirteen million dollars to construct a new treatment facility to remove PFAS contamination and other metals from our water system. We would like to thank Sen. Michelle Brooks and Rep. Kathy Rapp for assistance with the project. Also, thanks to our engineers (GPI, Inc.) and our geologists (Groundwater Resources) for the work they did on design and paperwork. Construction will take place starting next year. More information will be in future newsletters.

Water Leaks:

Water line breaks and leaks occur in the system. We attempt to make repairs as soon as possible. We must wait to dig until other utilities (i.e. National Fuel Gas) mark their lines in the area.

Borough Office Closed:

The Borough Office will be closed on Thursday November 28th and will open again on Tuesday December 3rd. Remember that water payments are DUE by November 20th.

No Burning Leaves (including leaves on limbs):

Anyone burning leaves will lose their burn permit and be fined \$500.00 per day.

Leaves & Leaf Pick-up:

After the first of October we started picking up leaves. Rake them out to the edge of the street (NOT on it). Make sure there are no stones or other debris in the leaves. Pile sticks separately. Remember that wet leaves must be dried out before we can pick them up.

Snow Parking Regulations:

Not long after the leaves fall, snow begins to drop! From November to April the snow parking ordinance is in effect. No Parking along any of the streets on Saeger-Heights. No parking along Erie and Main Streets from midnight to 7:00 am. **And** odd-even parking on all other streets. Call the office if you have questions.

If They Miss Your Garbage:

If your garbage pick-up is missed, contact the Borough Office as Soon As Possible. Call that day or first thing the next morning. They will pick it up as soon as possible. Occasionally, the refuse contractor has a new driver working, and they are not familiar with all the streets and alleys. Garbage must be out at the curb by 8:00 am.
