## Water Project Update:

The new treatment plant and water lines will be in service late next spring or early next summer. Construction is going well as planned, and the contractors are keeping disruptions to a minimum.

The Borough is planning on offering to e-mail water bills to customers starting in December of this year.

### To sign up...

E-mail the Borough and state you want your water/refuse bills e-mailed to you.

The Borough will confirm we received your e-mail, and reply back with the details.

NOTE: We cannot automatically deduct from your bank account. You can pay with your online banking, as before, but you must include your Borough account number.

Customers that wish to continue to have their bills mailed to them will receive a \$1 monthly charge per unit.

## **Leaves: Pickup is over Soon... until Spring**

Shortly the Borough will discontinue picking up leaves until spring. You can rake leaves into CLEAR bags and store them away from the streets, put them out in the spring.

## **Political Signs:**

Sign size is limited by Zoning.

• (No more than five (5) 2 ft. by 2 ft. signs are permitted on a property) • Signs over 16 sq. ft. (4ft. by 4ft.) require a permit. • No political signs on Borough Parks or Roundabouts. Signs at the Borough Building are limited to 24 hours before an election and 48 hours after. (After 48 hrs. we will dispose of them!)

## **Snow Parking – Starts November 1<sup>st</sup>:**

Be prepared for winter. Review of the streets affected, and the days and times. (Nov. 1 to April 1)

- No Parking Any Time: All the streets on Saeger-Heights.
- No Parking midnight to 7:00 am: Main Street and Erie Street.
- No Parking Odd-Even days:
  - no parking on Odd days (1-3-5- etc.) on the South and East sides of all other streets.
  - no parking on Even days (2-4-6 etc.) on the North and West sides of all other streets.



## **Christmas Lights:**

Anyone who would like to help put up the Christmas lights this year, please contact the Borough Office.

## **Annual Tractor Parade:**

This year's tractor parade will be on Saturday night November 22nd at 6:30 pm. It will run along Euclid Ave. and Grant St., as in previous years.



## **Use your Post Office Box Number:**

Beginning in October, for customers that have a PO Box number, all mail that does NOT have the PO Box will be returned by the Post Office. If you have a complaint, give it to the Post Office ...NOT the Borough Office.

## **Private snow plowing**

Remember: when you plow snow or blow snow (or hire it to be done) it is illegal to plow snow across streets or place snow onto someone else's property.



## **Snow on Main St. Sidewalks**

The Borough will blow snow from all the Main Street sidewalks again this year. However, it may not be done until later in the morning. Property owners are responsible for cleaning off snow and ice in the meantime.

## **Safety Tip: Get Ready for Winter!**

- Have your furnace checked.
- Check your CO detector
- Winterize your vehicle.
- Make sure you have a snow shovel.
- Shut off outside water spigots
- Add stabilizer to your summer power equipment such as lawn mowers
- Change filters in your furnace
- Change batteries in your smoke detectors
- Put a snow brush in your vehicle
- Put on winter windshield wipers
- Shut off power to your Air Conditioner
