Daylight Saving Ends Nov. 3rd:

Remember to “Fall Back” at 2:00 am on Nov. 3rd. Set clocks back and gain an hour of sleep!

Leaves & Leaf Pick-up:

After the first of October we will start picking leaves. Rake them out to the edge of the street (NOT on it). Make sure there are no stones or other debris in the leaves. Pile sticks separately. Remember that wet leaves must be dried out before we can pick them up.



Snow Parking Regulations:

Not long after the leaves fall, snow begins to drop! From November to April the snow parking ordinance is in effect. No Parking along any of the streets on Saeger-Heights. No parking along Erie and Main Streets from midnight to 7:00 am. **And** odd-even parking on all other streets. Call the office if you have questions.

Hydrant Flushing:

The Borough flushes all Fire Hydrants twice a year...once in the spring and once in the fall. Watch the Borough web site for notification when we are flushing. If you get dirty water, just run spigots until it is clear.



Lead & Copper Pipes:

Signs:

Sign size is limited by Zoning. ●All signs on a property can be no more than 16 sq. ft. combined, without a permit.
● (No more than five (5) 2 ft. by 2 ft. signs are permitted) ●Signs over 16 sq. Ft. (4ft. by 4ft.) require a permit.
●No political signs on Borough Parks or Roundabouts. Signs at the Borough Building are limited to 24 hours before an election and 48 hours after. (After 48 hrs. we throw them away!)

If They Miss Your Garbage:

If your garbage pick-up is missed, contact the Borough Office as Soon As Possible. Call that day or first thing the next morning. They will pick it up the next day. Occasionally, the refuse contractor has a new driver working, and they are not familiar with all the streets and alleys. Garbage must be out at the curb by 8:00 am.

Landlords & Newsletters:

We suggest landlords provide copies of the newsletters to all tenants or advise them they can pick up a free copy at the Borough Building. It will keep them informed on local regulations.

Basketball Hoops:

Any permitted sports equipment (such as portable basketball hoops.) must be removed from the street right-of-way between Nov. 1 of each year and April 1st of the following year. They must be moved at least **30 feet** from the center of the street.
