Part A: Animal Regulations

(OR1-1893) (Section 21)

## 100.00 Ride in dangerous Manner:

100.10 It shall be illegal for any person who shall ride or drive any horse, mare, mule, donkey, or jackass, single, double, tandem or otherwise, in or out of harness, in a dangerous or violent manner, in any other the streets, alleys or public grounds of said Borough.

# 200.00 Penalty Section:

200.10 Shall upon conviction of such offense on complaint duly made before the District Justice for said borough, forfeit and pay a Class D fine as set by resolution of Council and costs at the discretion of the District Justice, for the use of said Borough.

### 300.00 Sidewalks and Trees:

300.10 It shall be unlawful for any person to ride, drive or lead a horse, horses, teams or cattle on the sidewalks or to hitch the same to, or near to trees along the streets or public ground:

## 400.00 Penalty Section:

Any person convicted of so offending or complaint duly made before the District Justice for said borough shall pay a Class D fine as set by resolution of Council and costs at the discretion of the District Justice.

Such fine shall not be a bar any suit the owner of such sidewalk or trees may bring for damages resulting from such unlawful act.
